Purpose of Summits: To promote awareness of MAT options and to increase the number of practitioners using the waiver to prescribe buprenorphine in an office-based setting.

Format: Each one-day summit consists of four hours of live waiver training in the morning for practitioners (physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, clinical nurse specialists, certified registered nurse anesthetists, and certified nurse midwives). The afternoon sessions will address challenges for practitioners' offices and are open to practitioners as well as clinical and administrative staff.
